

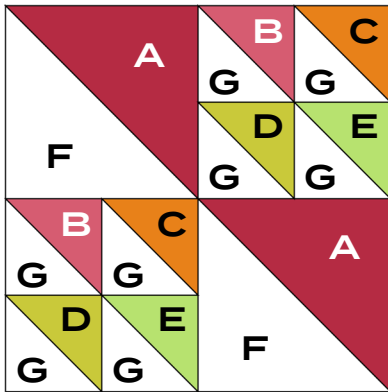
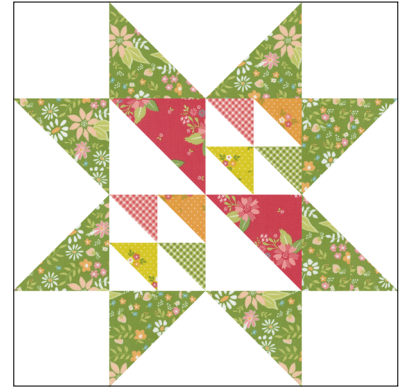

Cutting Instructions

	8" Block (8 1/2" unfinished)	16" Block (16 1/2" unfinished)
Medium/Dark (A)	(1) 3" square	(1) 5" square
Medium (B)	(1) 2" square	(1) 3" square
Medium (C)	(1) 2" square	(1) 3" square
Medium (D)	(1) 2" square	(1) 3" square
Medium (E)	(1) 2" square	(1) 3" square
Light (F)	(1) 3" square	(1) 5" square
Light (G)	(4) 2" squares	(4) 3" squares

Designer Note: Follow the block guide shown for fabric placement.

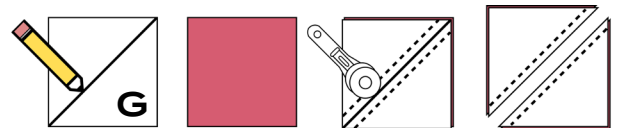
Units are labeled A-G.

Piecing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) F – square using an erasable marker or pencil.
2. Place (1) F – square with (1) A – square, right sides together.
3. Sew a 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line.
4. Cut along the drawn diagonal line, making a total of (2) A/F large HST units.
5. Trim large HST units using the following guide for 8" and 16" blocks:
 - a. 8" Block: 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished.
 - b. 16" Block: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.
6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) G – squares using an erasable marker or pencil.
7. Make square combinations by pairing (1) G – square with each B-E square, right sides together. There should be (4) square combinations.
8. Repeat HST unit assembly techniques described in Steps 3-4 to make a total of (8) small HST units. There should be (2) small HST units from each colorway (B/G, C/G, D/G and E/G).
9. Trim small HST units using the following guide for 8" and 16" blocks:
 - a. 8" Block: 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" unfinished.
 - b. 16" Block: 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished.

10. Arrange (1) of each small HST unit colorway (B/G, C/G, D/G and E/G) into a 4-patch unit as shown. Ensure small HST units are rotated in the same direction.

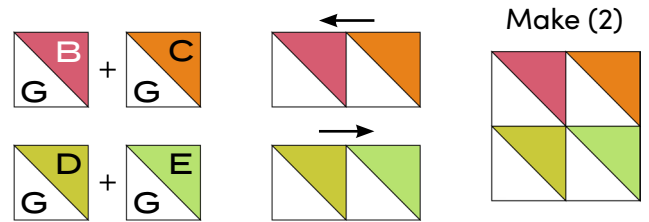
11. Sew together, alternating pressing directions.

12. Use the following guide for 4-patch unit sizes for 8" and 16" blocks:

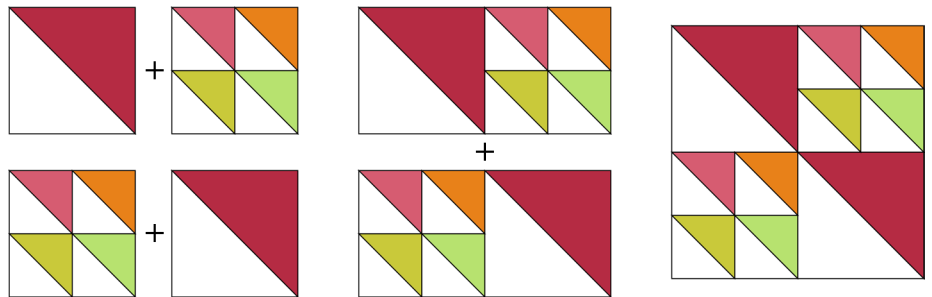
a. 8" Block: 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished.

b. 16" Block: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.

13. Repeat to make (2) identical 4-patch units.



14. Arrange the large HST units and the 4-patch units to form the November block center. Reference the diagram for the rotation of units. Sew together, pressing seams toward the large HST units.

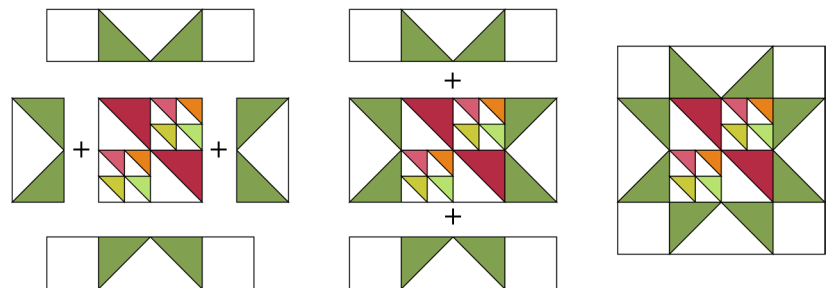


15. Use the following guide for November block center sizes:

a. 8" Block: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.

b. 16" Block: 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished.

16. Arrange the prepared Star Border pieces around the November block center and assemble as shown. Reference the Cutting Chart for unfinished block sizes.
