

Old Glory - 12" block

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MATERIALS

- = Cut in half diagonally.
 □ = Cut into quarters diagonally.

Cream print #1

- 1 square, $3\frac{1}{4}" \times 3\frac{1}{4}"$ □ (A)
 2 squares, $2\frac{7}{8}" \times 2\frac{7}{8}"$ □ (B)

Navy-striped fabric

- 1 square, $3\frac{1}{4}" \times 3\frac{1}{4}"$ □ (A)

Navy print

- 2 squares, $3\frac{1}{4}" \times 3\frac{1}{4}"$ □ (C)

2 red prints

- 1 rectangle, $2\frac{3}{8}" \times 6\frac{3}{4}"$, from each fabric (D)
 1 rectangle, $2\frac{1}{8}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$, from each fabric (E)

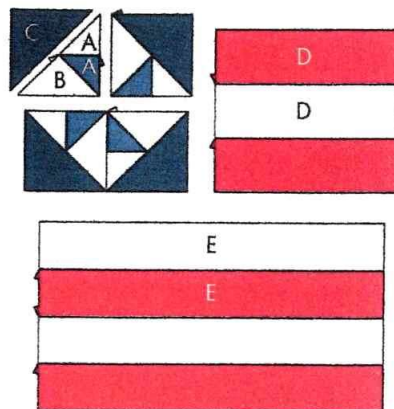
Cream print #2

- 1 rectangle, $2\frac{3}{8}" \times 6\frac{3}{4}"$ (D)
 2 rectangles, $2\frac{1}{8}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ (E)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Join pieces A-C to make the pinwheel.
2. Join the D pieces to make a unit and sew it to the side of the pinwheel unit.

3. Join the E pieces and sew them to the bottom of the pinwheel unit to complete the block. (Trim to $12\frac{1}{2}"$)
